**Its** is the possessive adjective form of **it**.

Possessive adjectives have no apostrophe – **My, Your, His, Her, Its, Their, Our**

They come before the noun.

This is **its** wheel.

The wheel belongs to the train.

In the English language, **it's** one of **its** most confusing words.

Many people confuse **it's** and **its**.

Don't you do **it**.
